

Camden Military Academy Dual Enrollment

Camden Military Academy high school students have the opportunity to earn credit in both high school and college while taking courses from the University of South Carolina in the Dual Enrollment Program.

- The primary purpose of offering dual credit courses is to deliver high-quality experiences to high-performing high school students.
- Dual credit courses are suitable to challenge students who are mastering the high school curriculum and who require college-level course work that is more rigorous than high school curriculum.
- Dual credit courses enrich and extend the high school curriculum and provide introductory college coursework.
- Dual credit courses promote gradual transition to the college work load.
- Dual credit courses give students a jump start on college.

Dual credit courses carry an honors weight.

Course Descriptions

Economics (ECON)

- **224 – Introduction to Economics. (3)** Micro-and macroeconomic principles of markets, government policy, and household or firm decision-making.

English Language and Literature (ENGL)

- **101 – Composition. (3)** A course in the composing process with attention to invention, arrangement, and style, and closely supervised practice in reading and writing essays.
- **102 – Composition and Literature. (3)** (Prereq: ENGL 101) A course in the writing of expository and critical essays with an introduction to literature and including a research paper.

Government and International Studies (GINT)

- **201 – American National Government. (3)** The formation and development of the national government, its organization and powers.

History (HIST)

- **111, 112 – History of the United States from Discovery to the Present Day. (3 each)** A general survey of the United States from the era of discovery to the present, emphasizing major political, economic, social, and intellectual developments. First semester: to 1865; second semester: since 1865.

Mathematics (Math)

- **111 – Basic College Mathematics. (3)** (Prereq: qualification through placement or a grade of C or better in MATH 100) Basic college algebra; linear and quadratic equations, inequalities, functions and graphs of functions, exponential and logarithm functions, systems of equations.
- **122 – Calculus for Business Administration and Social Sciences. (3)** (Prereq: qualification through placement or a grade of C or better in MATH 111 or 115) Derivatives and integrals of elementary algebraic, exponential, and logarithmic functions. Maxima, minima, rate of change, motion, work, area under a curve, and volume.

Psychology (PSYC)

- **101 – Introduction to Psychology. (3)** An introduction to and survey of the basic concepts and findings within the field of psychology.

Dual Enrollment Class Attendance Policy

Students are obligated to complete all assigned work promptly, to attend class regularly, and to participate in whatever class discussion may occur.

Absence from more than 10 percent of the scheduled class sessions, whether excused or unexcused, is excessive and the instructor may choose to exact a grade penalty for such absences.

The instructor's attendance policy should be ascertained by the student at the beginning of the semester. It is of particular importance that a student who anticipates absences in excess of 10 percent of the scheduled class sessions receive prior approval from the Instructor before the last day to change schedule as published in the academic and refund calendars on the registrar's Web site.

It must be emphasized that the "10 percent rule" stated above applies to both excused and unexcused absences. Faculty members should notify classes specifically of the attendance policy which they intend to follow in each class.

9 classes = 10%

Missing 10-14 = Lower 1 letter grade
15-18 = Lower 2 letter grades
19+ = "F"

Absences due to school sponsored trip, where your participation is mandatory will NOT be counted against you (ie: sports, Jr. Leadership).
