



Junior Advisement Program: Preparing Students for Senior Year and Beyond

Building the Skills and Clarity to Succeed

Junior year is the bridge between exploration and action — the time when students refine their goals, strengthen their academic profile, and begin preparing for the important decisions of senior year. At *Camden Military Academy*, our Junior Advisement Program offers a structured, personalized approach that equips each student with the tools, knowledge, and confidence they need to take the next step toward their future.

From test preparation to résumé building, college research to early application guidance, we ensure our juniors finish the year ready to hit the ground running as seniors. We meet with juniors regularly throughout the school year to monitor progress, offer advice, and connect them with resources that match their individual goals.

Fall Semester: Setting a Strong Foundation

September – Junior Advisement Kickoff

- Junior Advisement Orientation is held to outline the year's goals and key milestones.
- Information like college choices, military service, ROTC, technical school, or career plans is collected.

- For students considering ROTC scholarships or military academies, an interest form is collected and future steps are discussed.
- Each student is provided with a personalized Junior Advisement schedule for the school year.

October – Individualized Planning & Early Applications

- Academic data, test scores, and graduation plans are reviewed in personalized meetings.
- Training is held for creating a high school résumé.
- Discuss the purpose of the PSAT and review prior scores.
- Administer the PSAT.
- Student applications are reviewed for JROTC scholarships and service academies.

November – Mid-Semester Review

- Personalized meetings are held with advisor to refine plans and address any academic concerns.
- Discussions about spring SAT/ACT testing opportunities and registration dates are held.
- Date collected for any early college applications submitted and upcoming university application deadlines are reviewed.

Spring Semester: Moving Toward Action

January – JROTC & Academic Planning

- Students are assisted with registering for the spring ACT or SAT.

- Feedback is provided on student résumés to strengthen future applications.

February – GPA & Testing Review

- Individualized meetings are held with students to discuss updated GPAs and recent SAT/ACT results.
- College considerations are reviewed in light of academic performance and standardized test scores.

March – Common App Introduction

- Orientation is held for using CommonApp.
- Students are guided in setting up their Common App profiles and selecting colleges of interest.
- Students are registered for spring SAT/ACT testing as needed.

April – Financial Aid & Year-End Wrap-Up

- Introductions for the basics of financial aid, including FAFSA and scholarship opportunities.
- Discussions on the importance of recommendation letters are held and the Senior Year Checklist is reviewed.
- Students begin drafting college essays for the summer.
- Students are assigned to their senior-year advisor for the upcoming year.

Our Junior Advisement Program Offers..

- Forward Planning – Juniors enter senior year already prepared for the application process.
- Individualized Support – Regular one-on-one meetings ensure every student gets personal attention.
- Confidence for the Future – Students learn the skills and steps needed to pursue their post-graduation goals.
